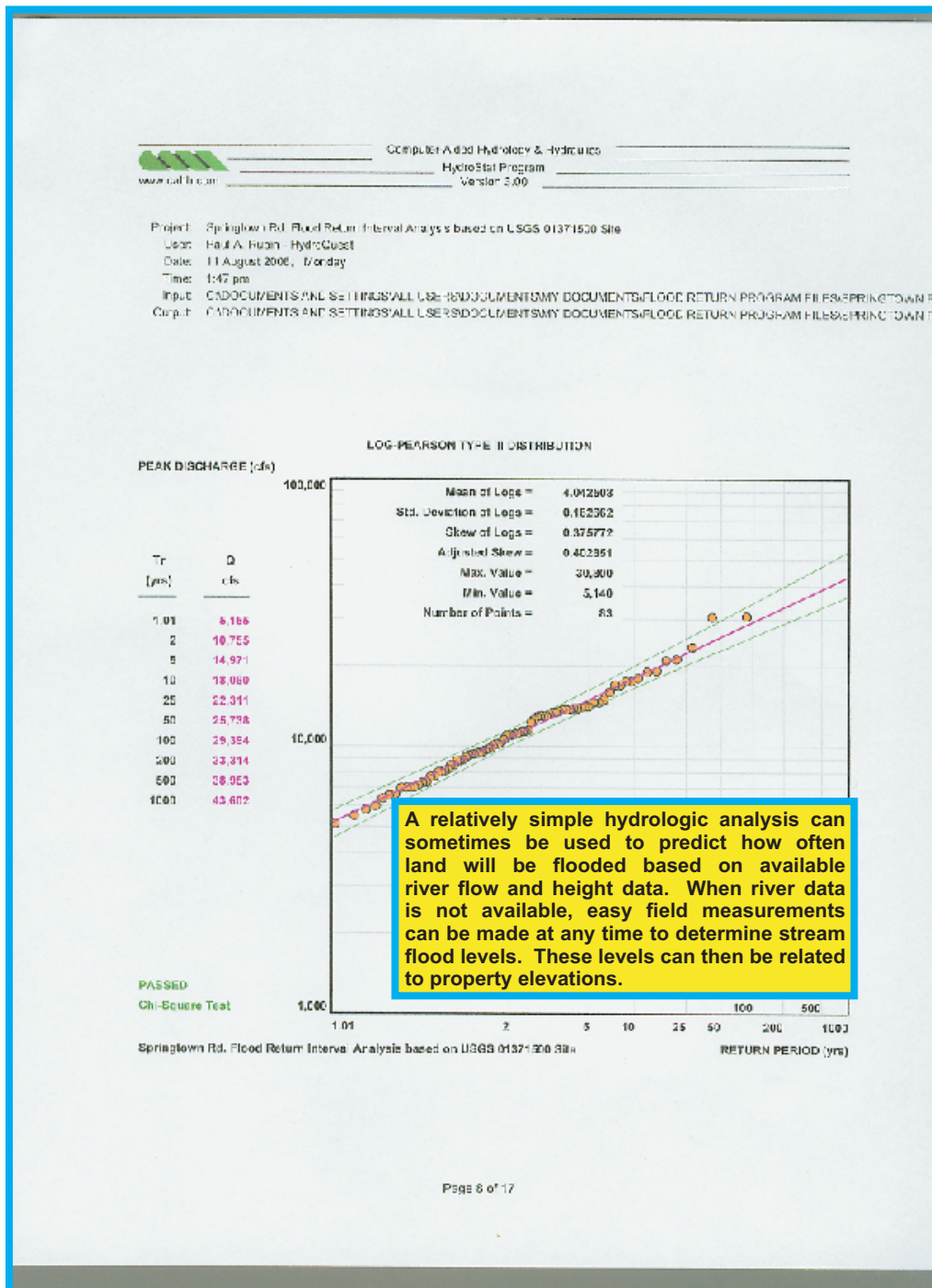


Unfortunately, home sales do sometimes occur without prospective buyers being aware that their desired property is located in a flood-plain. Sometimes the frequency of flooding, as depicted here, is infrequent - yet, the safety of family members may be placed in serious jeopardy and the risk of significant property damage may be high. If you are considering buying property within hundreds of feet of a stream or river, consider having HydroQuest evaluate the setting.



A relatively simple hydrologic analysis can sometimes be used to predict how often land will be flooded based on available river flow and height data. When river data is not available, easy field measurements can be made at any time to determine stream flood levels. These levels can then be related to property elevations.
